Design: Quilter's own choice, but the quilt must contain log cabin blocks

Techniques: Quilter's own choice: Hand or machine piecing, appliqué, quilting; other techniques as desired

Size: Maximum 36" x 36" (No minimum size)

Due Date: Turn in at October meeting, (10/14/10) **or**

Other requirements:

Sleeve: All quilts (except miniatures 12" and under) must have a sleeve attached to the top back for hanging. The sleeve opening must be 4" wide after it is attached.

Label: Place a fabric identification label securely fastened to the back, bottom, left corner of the quilt. (A pinned paper label is not acceptable.) Please include your name, year and the quilt name. You may add any additional information you choose. Cover this label with another piece of fabric basted or tacked on to cover the information until the judging has been completed.

Entry Form: Complete the entry form completely. Include in the statement about your quilt any inspiration for your design, choice of colors, any new techniques you tried, etc. (The types of things you like to read on the artist's statement when you go to a quilt show.)

Protection: Provide a means of protecting your quilt (pillow case, bag, etc.). The case doesn't have to be fancy. Make sure the bag also identifies you.

Wish List: Exhibition of all entries at the Mancuso Show in November
Quilts will be judged before the Mancuso show, exhibited there, then shown again at December meeting with recognition of participants and winners.

- Entries will be available for pick up at the end of the December 2010 MCQ Guild meeting. Quilts not picked up will be held by the Executive Committee until pick up is arranged.
